Learn how soil is formed

Activity description

Soil is made up of 45% minerals from rocks, 25% water, 25% air, 5% organic matter, along with the action of time, activity of living things and specific climatic conditions.

This activity is an interactive, visual and silly way to understand the above. Can be used as a starting point to any session exploring soil.

Following the attached recipe, use creative ways of imagining the ingredients through found objects to make soil (opportunity to have a discussion around respecting live animals too, so nothing is harmed in the making of soil!).

Soil Recipe

Ingredients:

1 huge rock

3 medium pebbles

5 small stones

4 twigs

3 fallen leaves

1 dead animal*

Sprinkling of wee beasties*

Dash of water

Dollop of air

Sprig of time
